BUZZING WITH BEES

Discover the importance of pollinators through the life cycle of native bees and learn bee identification. Understand issues impacting bees and how you can help. View our observation beehive with live honeybees! Each student will leave with a stick of local honey.

WILD WATER CYCLES

Investigate the water cycle and determine the connections between lakes, rivers, and streams here in the Alouette Watershed. WATERSHED EDUCATION TOUR

Learn about the importance of a watershed through the life cycle of Pacific salmon and the species that rely on them. Discover how everything is connected within the watershed and understand the importance of healthy rivers. Engage in an aquatic invertebrate study and investigate the diversity of creatures that live in our streams. Determine how the diet of a salmon changes throughout its journey to the ocean. Wrap up your day in the park with a forest tour to learn about the value of native species in our ecosystems, and the lasting impact of invasive species.
